The Office of the Attorney General for the Commonwealth of Virginia (hereinafter, "Office") acknowledges receipt of the above-referenced correspondence in which you seek certain information pursuant to the Virginia Freedom of Information Act, Virginia Code Section 2.2-3700, *et seq.* (hereinafter, "FOIA"). Specifically, your request states:

Please provide me with copies of all correspondence and/or other records, and their accompanying information including also any attachments, which communicate the position that "The Office [OAG] ultimately declined to participate in the NYU fellow program." The reference is to OAG's September 15, 2017 "application of the Office of the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Virginia to hire a New York University School of Law fellow as a Special Assistant Attorney General through the State Energy & Environmental Impact Center".

OAG was informed on December 6, 2017 by David Hayes, in an email to Donald Anderson, Subject "Special Assistant Attorney General", that OAG was awarded the Special Assistant Attorney General for which it applied.

On February 19, 2019, your Office informed the Circuit Court for the City of Richmond in Case No. CL18-5666, in an affidavit by Donald D. Anderson, that "The Office ultimately declined to participate in the NYU fellow program." I seek any record communicating that to NYU, or to any other party.

Please be advised that there are no records responsive to your request.
